Successful relocation of villages (three total):

1. Vunidogoloa village in Cakaudrove Province
2. Tukuraki village in Ba
3. Denimanu village on Yadua Island – rehabilitation of homes that were destroyed in Hurricane Evan in 2012.

Villages partially relocated (two total):

4. Vunisavisavi village in Cakaudrove province
5. Nagasauva village in Udu Point, Cakaudrove

Planned relocations in initial stages (two total):

6. Narikoso village in Ono, Kadavu
7. Waciwaci District School in Lakeba, Lau

Seawalls completed (six total):

8. Kiuva village in Tailevu (Hon. Prime Minister's village)
9. Kumi village in Tailevu (Hon. Inia Seruiratu's village)
10. Wainibokasi river bank protection in Tailevu
11. River bank protection in Buretu village in Tailevu
12. Matainoco seawall in Tailevu
13. Daku village in Tailevu - drainage improvement and salt water intrusion protection works

Plans for further seawalls (two total):

14. Naivakacau in Tailevu – to prevent salt water intrusion
15. Vabea village in Ono, Kadavu
